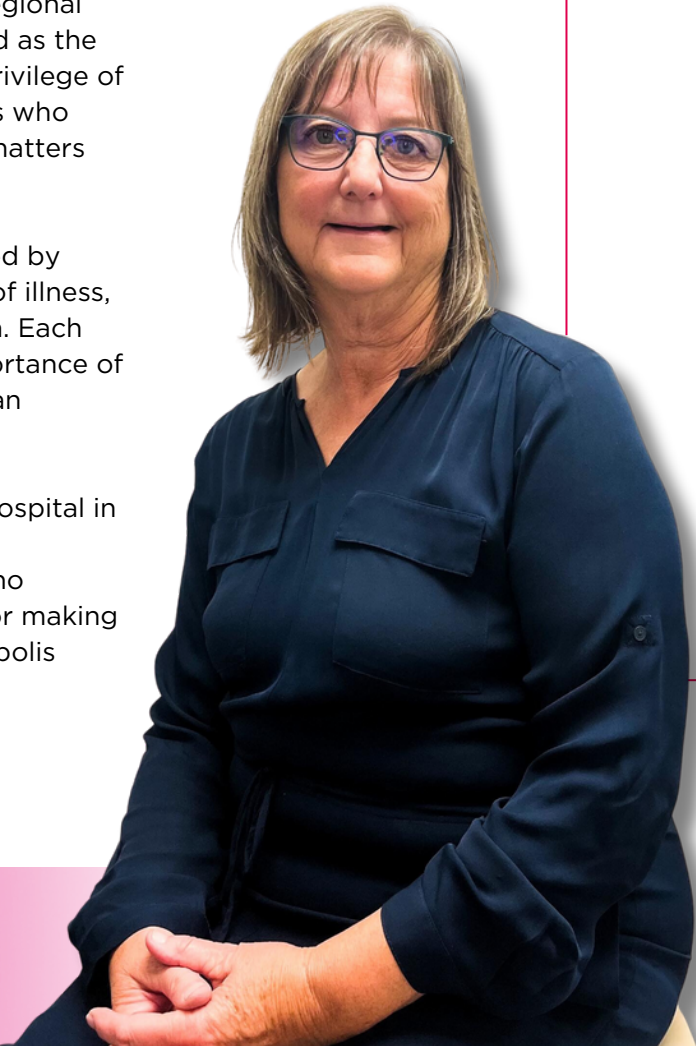
## PRESIDENT’S MESSAGE

Another year has quickly passed and much has been accomplished! As we moved through and out of another year of Covid restrictions, we continued to adapt and grow.

The Breathe Well Campaign to purchase essential pulmonary function equipment was launched in early 2022. Activities that focused on this equipment included our Health in Harmony Radiothon in partnership with AVR, Valley Golf Day, Valley Vineyard Series, the Black & White Dinner and Auction with Mike and Sandy Reid, and the annual Festival of Lights! The financial target of \$250,000 was exceeded and through the generosity of donors, individuals, major gifts, legacy gifts, sponsors and grants, Valley Regional Hospital Foundation has received almost \$2 million dollars this year!

The Foundation continues to raise funds to purchase essential equipment for Valley Regional Hospital. This is our primary focus, and we are committed to helping to provide the most up to date equipment so that our doctors and staff can continue to provide excellent healthcare. Valley Regional Hospital is a regional referral centre providing services not available in community hospitals. Over the last year, thousands of visits were made including:



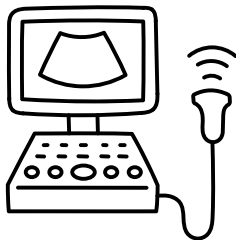

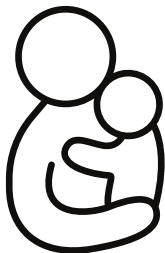

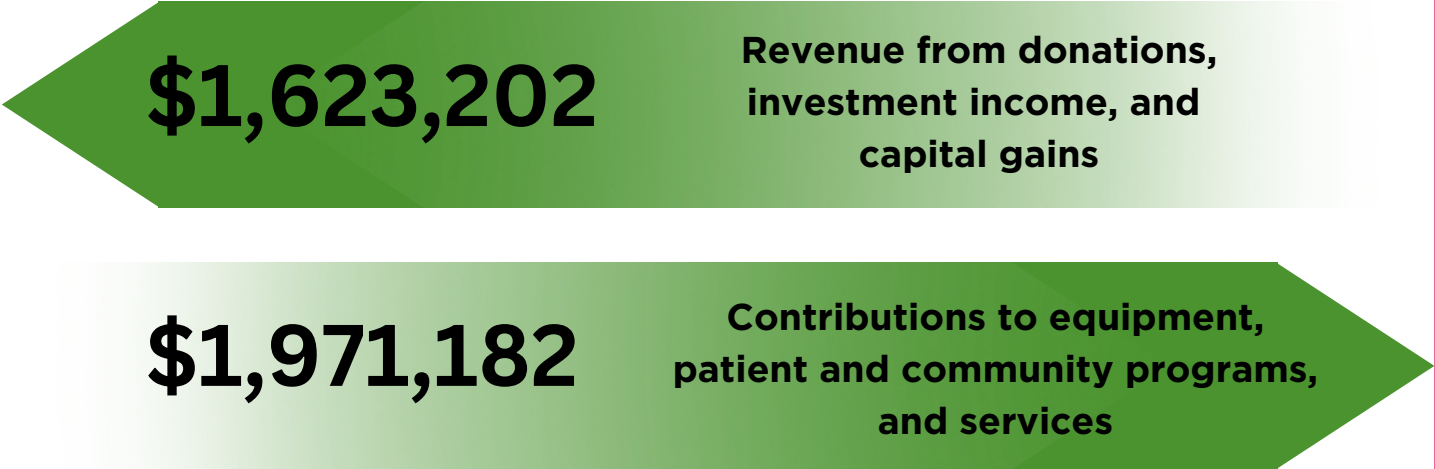

# Our Future

## BREATHE WELL CAMPAIGN

Donors believe we all have a responsibility to ensure our community and loved ones have access to the best healthcare. Thanks to our donors who share the vision of greater healthcare close to home, Annapolis Valley residents have improved access and shorter wait times to receiving the treatment they need.

With completion of the **Breathe Well Campaign**, a new Pulmonary Function Test machine, with updated zone-compatible software, new bike, and portable spirometers were added to the Respiratory Therapy clinic. This means patients can continue to be assessed and monitored for breathing obstructions and lung disease within the Annapolis Valley.

For patients like **Mike Reid**, having the right tools saved his life when he was diagnosed as needing a double lung transplant. Mike and his family have the freedom to be able to continue to monitor his condition on a regular basis without taking on the additional stress of travelling for maintenance care.

Valley Regional Hospital’s healthcare teams help thousands of patients access healthcare close to home, and your donation to the Foundation has contributed **\$1,623,202** in funding to support new equipment.

## Our Comfort

### CANCER CARE FOR PATIENT ACCESS

Upon learning of a cancer diagnosis, families have to adjust their lifestyles to accommodate treatment plans, medical appointments and hospital visits.

Patients experience a variety of pressures which can impact their care and recovery. The *Cancer Care for Patient Access* fund is established to help families with financial barriers work with a Patient Navigator, like **Dianna Hutt**, to access Oncology treatment at Valley Regional Hospital.

Thanks to our donors who share the vision of health equity, in the last year, 119 patients were able access their chemotherapy treatments. The VRH Foundation understands how vital it is for all the residents in the community to access healthcare. Our goal is to make sure no one forgoes treatment due to financial barriers.

### PATIENT COMFORT CARE FUNDING

When you give to Valley Regional Hospital Foundation patient program funds, you are helping ensure that Annapolis Valley residents are able to find some comfort during stressful times, as well as access life-saving treatment.

Whether it is a simple item like a device charger on a long night, a toiletry bag in the morning, or assistance with transportation costs; your generosity resonates throughout the hospital, and reaches patients every day. In the past year, **\$160,000** was distributed to patient programs, comfort care items, and services in our community.

## Our community

Joan and Daryl Langille have been residents of the western Valley most of their lives; raising their children, starting and retiring business ventures. They have made themselves a community amongst family, friends and neighbours.

In May of 2022, upon feeling unwell and in extreme pain, the Langilles called 911 to rush Joan to Valley Regional Hospital for a suspected heart attack or appendicitis.

After being treated for the pain, and seeing Dr. Nette, it was discovered Joan had tumor. Within three weeks, Joan was scheduled for surgery at the Oncology Unit in Halifax.

Due to the care from our healthcare professionals -- the ambulance EMS teams, Emergency Unit, Dr. Nette, the Women & Child's Unit and Surgical Unit -- Joan's condition was diagnosed and treated. Thankfully, today Joan is cancer free.

### EQUIPPED EMERGENCY ROOMS

Valley Regional Hospital's Emergency teams treated more than **45,500 patients** this year. A vital component to delivering the best care possible is having up-to-date equipment.

Thanks to our generous donors, Valley Regional Hospital has the equipment, in your time of need -- like a new video laryngoscope and rapid infuser, used in medical emergencies requiring intubation and distribution of temperature controlled fluids. This equipment is often life-saving and necessary in Emergency situations.

### PHYSICIAN RECRUITMENT

The Foundation understands how vital it is to have the latest technology and equipment to attract and retain physicians and healthcare professionals. Because of our community of donors, the Foundation continues to fund areas of greatest need.

In partnership with Valley Regional Hospital, Nova Scotia Health, and the AVCC Physician Community Navigator; **17 new physicians** are working in the Annapolis Valley including specialists in Dermatology, Neurology, and Psychiatry.

In the last year, 14 locums provided physician relief and 167 medicine students did their elective rotations in the Annapolis Valley.

Our Healing

Matilda Jararuse has established roots in the Annapolis Valley over the past 14 years. Growing her family has been a long journey. After successfully carrying her first child, in September 2015, Matilda experienced the loss of her second baby at 34 weeks gestation due to a pregnancy liver condition.

Matilda and her family held their sweet Olivia Jane for a mere five hours. In the years since her loss, Matilda learned about a medical device called a Cuddle Cot.

In the event of neo-natal loss, a Cuddle Cot is a cooling bassinet that extends the time families have with their babies to preserve their memory.

Through Matilda’s efforts of advocating pregnancy liver conditions, hosting a Walk of Remembrance and her own jewelry sales; the Foundation was able to purchase a Cuddle Cot for Valley Regional Hospital this past year.

Matilda has since grown her family and now has two children, while continuing to raise awareness about pregnancy loss.

In memory of Olivia Jane, the Jararuse Family made an extraordinary impact on the Women & Child’s Unit at Valley Regional Hospital -- giving other families the gift of time, and finding healing for themselves.

COMMUNITY LED FUNDRAISERS

Matilda was able to raise 20% of the Cuddle Cot funds through her own fundraisers. Community groups and individuals continue to step up and give back in support of the health of their community. This past year our community contributed \$62,105 with 34 individual fundraisers.

Patients at Valley Regional Hospital benefit from these community-led fundraisers that support all aspects of the hospital -- from patient care to equipment purchases.

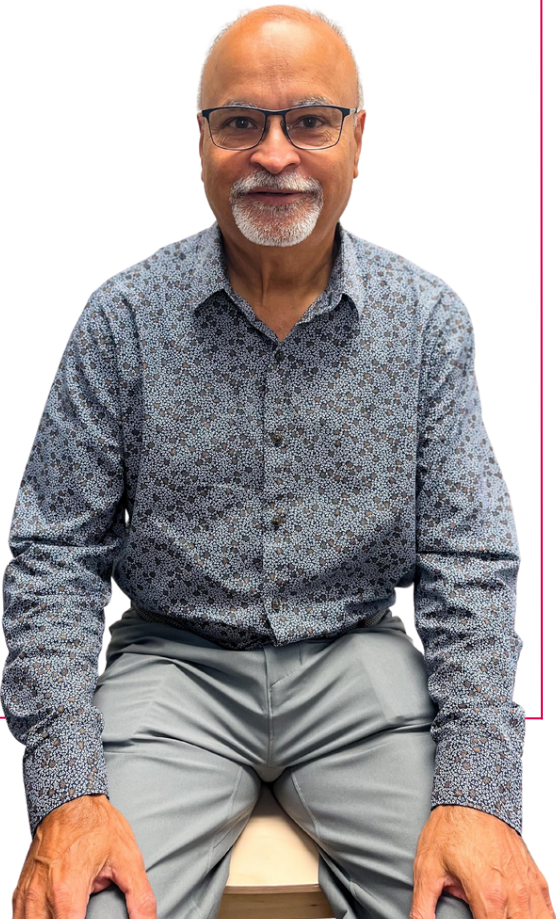

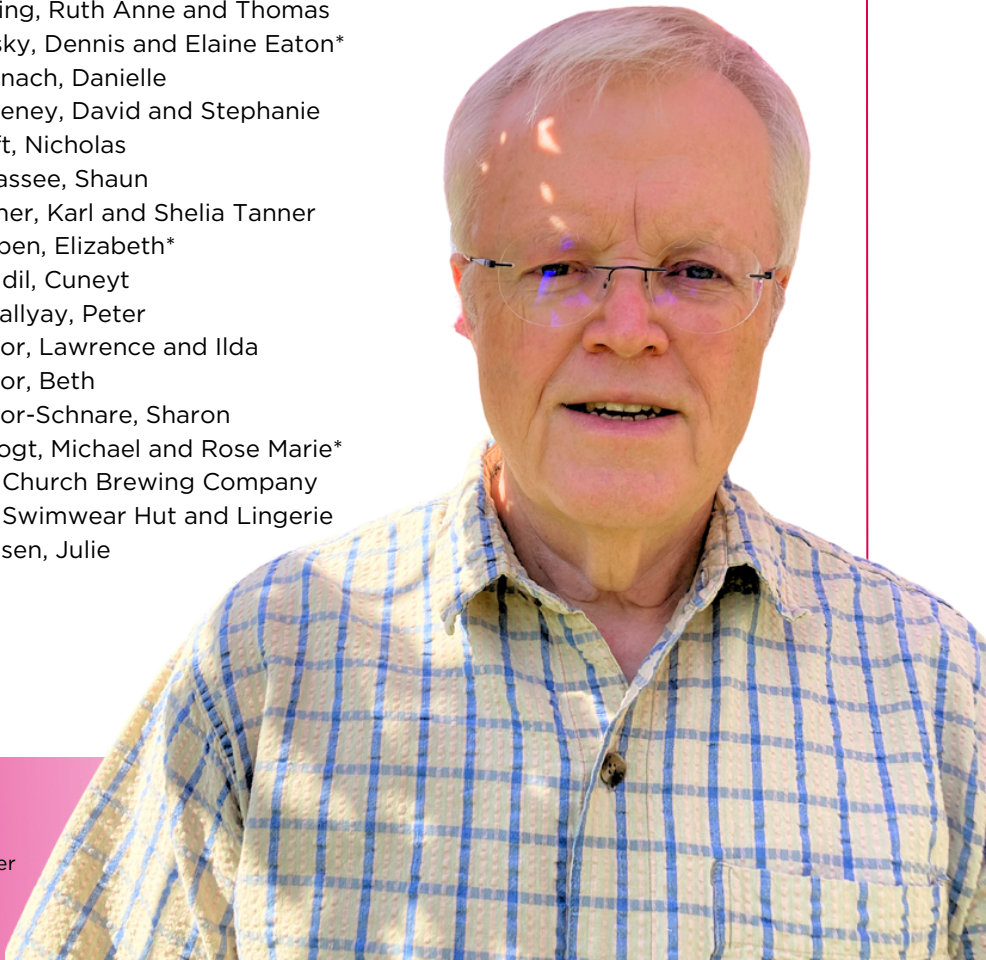

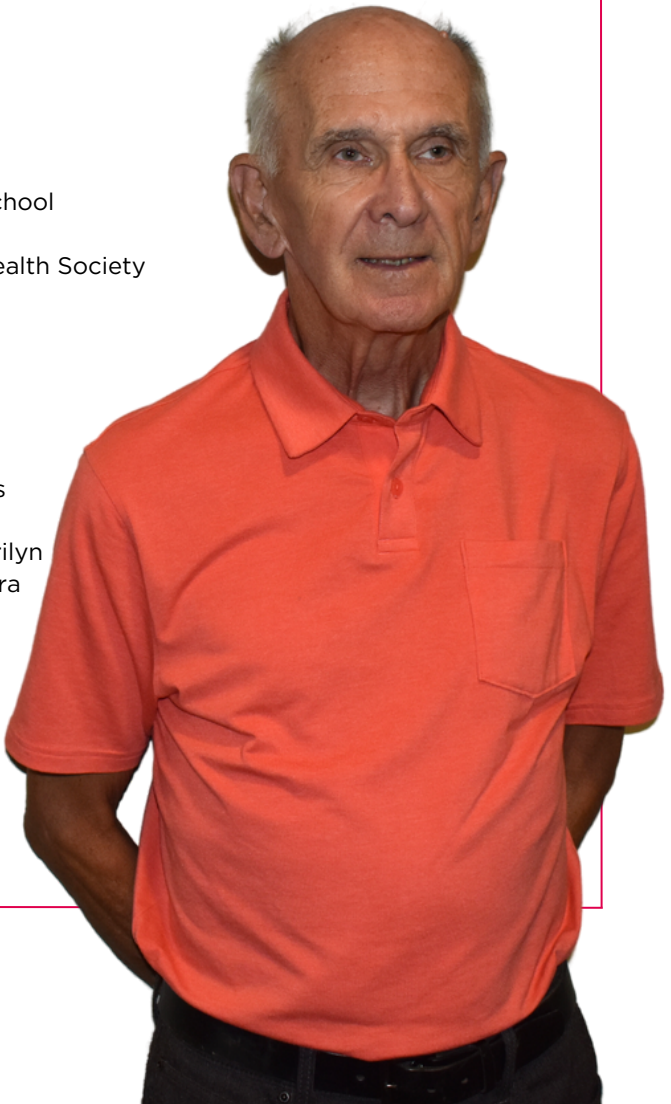
